Electric Glider Competition Rules.

Aims

- To encourage electric glider flying within the club.
- A club social event as well as an informal competition.

How will the competition be run?

- The flying of IC powered aircraft is not permitted during the competition.
- All aircraft are to be launched at the same time on the instruction of the Contest Director. (CD)
- Electric motors can run for 30 seconds and then on the instruction of the CD all motors are turned off. Slot time of 5 minutes starts from this time.
- One point is awarded for every second flown.
- Landing bonus of 30 points added for touch down and nose of the model coming to rest within a 4.8m diameter circle.
- Landing bonus of 50 seconds is added for touch down and nose of the model coming to rest within a 1.0m diameter circle.
- Pilots must give clear calls when they are landing.
- When save, models are to be retrieved from the strip.
- Sum of two flight times and any landing bonus will be added together to determine places.
- A re-launch is not allowed.
- CD decision is final.
